62nd Annual St. Joseph County SWCD Annual Meeting at St. Hedwig's

The St Joseph County SWCD was joined by 117 residents, producers, landowners, and conservation partners.

Brian Capouch was our keynote speaker and gave a presentation on the history of the Grand Kankakee Marsh in our area. Capouch, along with one of the supervisors, Chris Matthys, engaged the crowd with historical research on regions where the Grand Kankakee Marsh used to be located in St. Joseph County and how it was impacted by the Settlement Period in Northwestern Indiana. Using historical maps and passages from "Tales of Kankakee Land" by Charles Bartlett, as well as their own histories with the area, Capouch and Matthys captivated attendees with new information on the county that we call home.



Producers with Crop Insurance to Receive Premium Benefit for Cover Crops



Agricultural producers who have coverage under most crop insurance policies are eligible for a premium benefit from the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) if they planted cover crops during the 2022 crop year. To receive the benefit from this year's Pandemic Cover Crop Program (PCCP), producers must report cover crop acreage by **March 15, 2022**.
